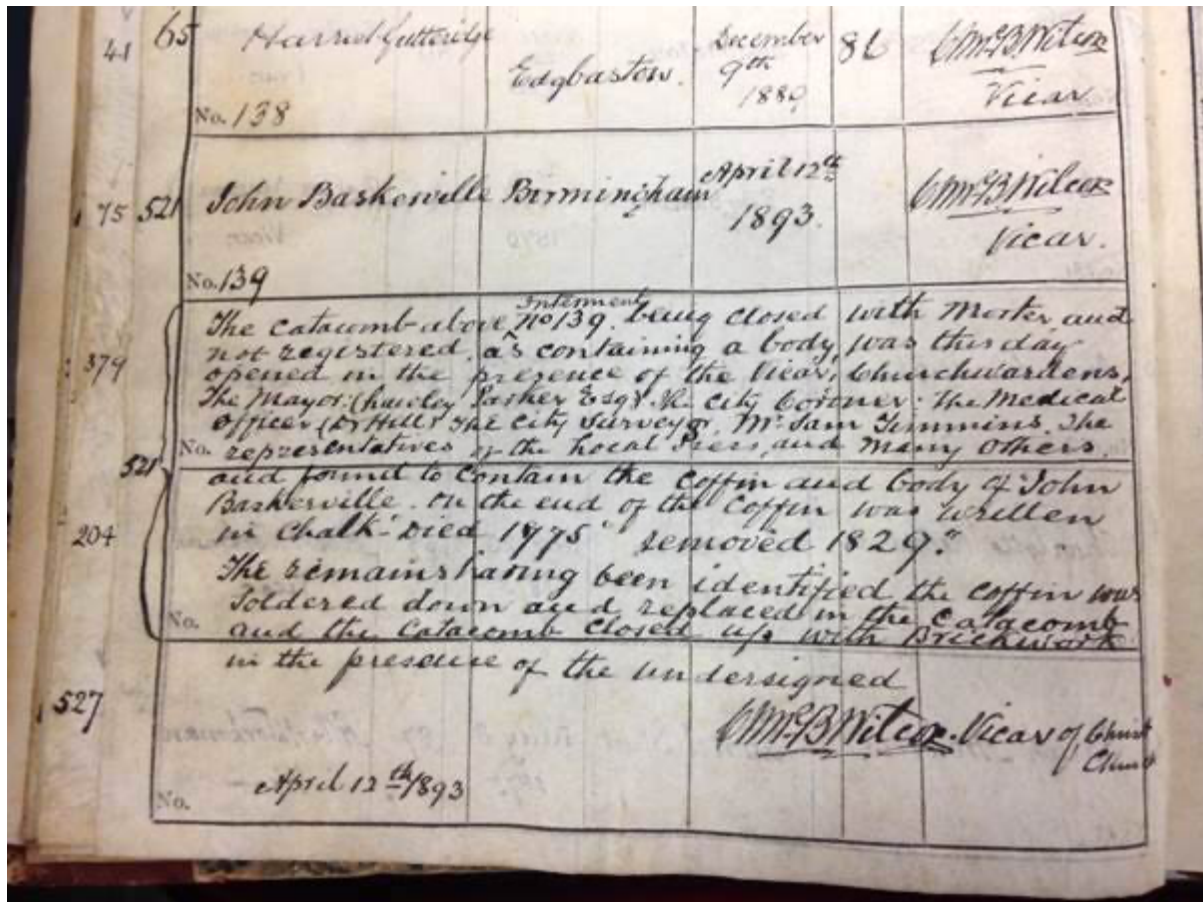


## John Baskerville



### Transcription

John Baskerville – Birmingham – April 12<sup>th</sup> 1893 – C M B Willcox Vicar.

No 139

The catacomb above Internment No 139 closed with mortar and not registered as containing a body, was this day opened in the presence of the Vicar, Churchwardens The mayor: (lawley Parker Esq) the City Coroner, The medical Officer (Dr Hill) the City Surveyor, Mr Sam Timmins, The representatives of the Local Press, and many others and found to contain the Coffin and body of John Baskerville on the end of the Coffin was written in chalk, "Died 1775 removed 1829".

The remains having been identified the Coffin was soldered down and replaced in the Catacomb and the Catacomb closed up with Brickwork in the presence of the undersigned

**Comment :** When Christ Church was demolished John Baskerville was reburied at Warstone Lane Church of England Cemetery in H 68 the exact position of which is unknown.
